The Aims of the Society

- To bring together those interested in family history and genealogy, primarily in West Middlesex and West London;
- to promote and encourage research into all aspects of family history and genealogy;
- to help co-ordinate transcription and indexing of records relating to the West Middlesex area;
- to publish literature.

Members

Our membership includes those who are experienced as well as those who are new to family history. The Society has something to offer both those with ancestral connections in the West Middlesex area, and those with an interest in family history who live locally and who can benefit from the general help that can be afforded by a local society.

Meetings

Meetings are held on the third Thursday of each month. They take place at Montague Hall, Montague Road, Hounslow, starting at 7.15pm for research in the Society's resources and indexes, lectures on aspects of family or local history commence at 8pm.

West Middlesex FHS Journal

The Society publishes a quarterly journal, distributed to all members. This contains articles on family history research in the area, on record sources and research methods, and on local history. It also includes details of Society meetings, projects and services, local and national family history news. A **Help!** section for those seeking assistance, and surname interests of new members are also regular features. All members are encouraged to make their own contribution to the publication.

Activities and Services

The Society's library includes exchange journals from many other UK and overseas family history societies, as well as reference books and transcripts, and can be accessed at the monthly meetings. A bookstall with guides to family and local history is also an established part of these evenings. For those living outside the area, there is a postal book service, supplying many titles, which are often only available locally.

The Society is not able to undertake research on behalf of members although advice on general matters can be provided.

A number of other services are offered by volunteers, to assist others in their researches. These include many unpublished indexes, and a successful Certificate Courier Service.

An important function of the Society is to undertake project work, aimed at facilitating access to local records through transcription and indexing projects.

Details of current activities can be found in the pages of the Journal.

A Surname Interests Directory listing research activities of members, is published biannually, and distributed free with the Journal.

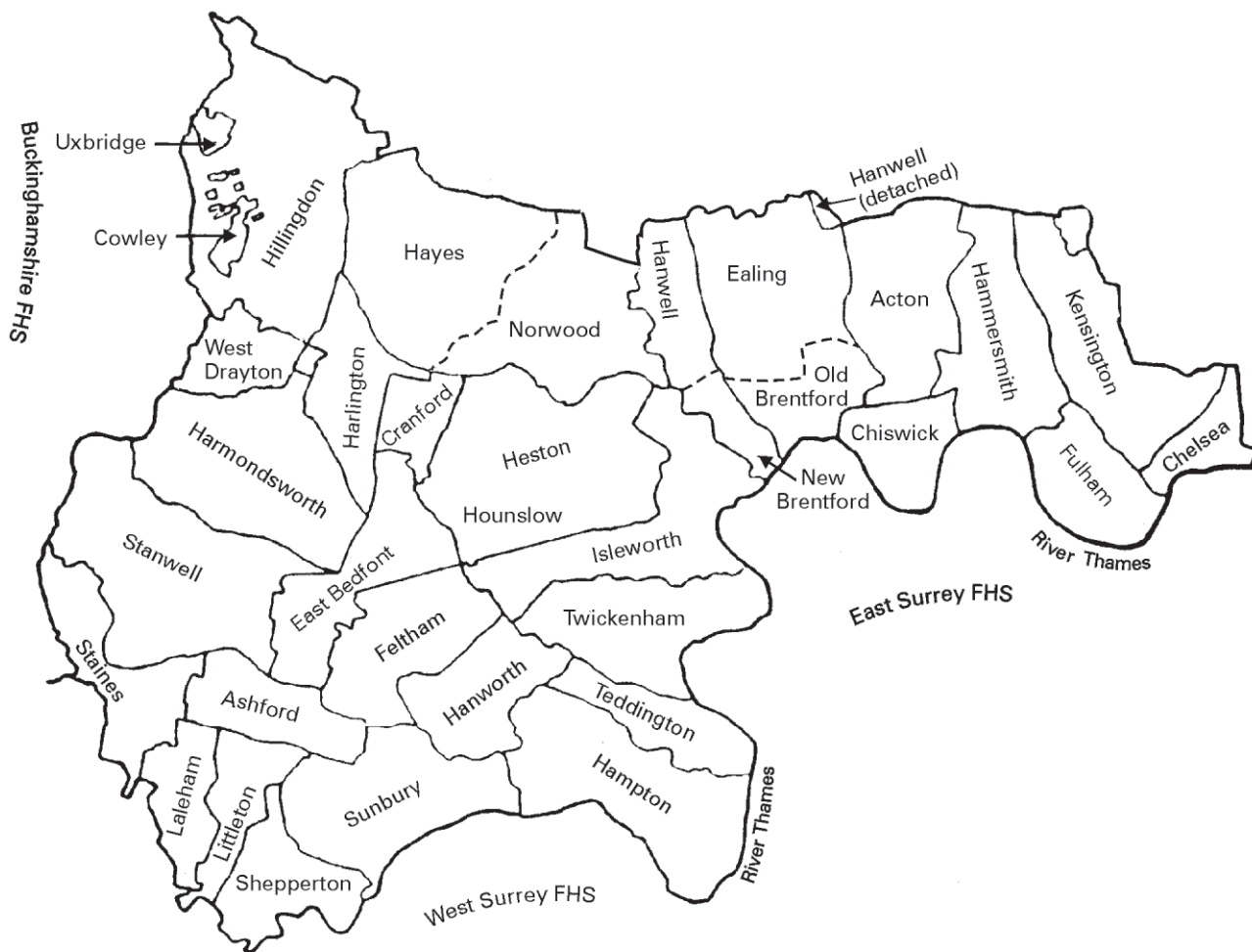
